

POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS

Access Cards, Waivers and Supervision by Adults/Minors with Waiver Forms:

Residents must have their access cards to enter the pool area.

All appropriate waivers must be on file with the District for entry into the pool area. Including, but not limited to, completed waivers of minors who are guests of residents.

Adults/Minors with Waiver Forms are responsible for supervising those individuals of non-swimming ability. Use of flotation devices does not replace active supervision.

Residents shall be responsible for damage to District property caused by their family and/or guests.

Guest Policy

Each household, regardless of the number of Users that reside therein, is limited to three (3) guests per day at the pool. There is no charge for these guests.

Special arrangements for four (4) or more guests must be made through Front Range Recreation (303-690-5243) at least 24 hours in advance.

Slide:

Only operational when lifeguards are present.

Only one person on the slide at a time.

After going down the slide, swim away from the area immediately.

No swimming under the slide.

No hanging on the slide.

Safety Breaks: Safety breaks will occur every hour for 15 minutes during which time no one is allowed in the pool.

Loss of Pool Privileges: Violation of the pool rules, regulations and/or instructions by the lifeguards can result in loss of pool privileges. Depending on the severity of the violation, the loss of pool privileges could be for the remainder of the day and up to forty-eight (48) hours by the lifeguards. The Board of Directors of the District can revoke pool privileges for longer periods of time.

Rules:

1. Obey the lifeguards at all times.
2. Proper swim attire is required.
3. Swim diapers are required for all individuals that do not have complete bodily function control.
4. Foul or abusive language is prohibited.
5. Do not prop open the door to the pool area.
6. Floating toys, rafts, rings, tubes and boards are allowed, at the discretion of the lifeguards.
7. Only service animals are allowed in the pool area.
8. Smoking, vaping, tobacco use and/or drug use is strictly prohibited.
9. No person having an infectious or communicable disease or open wound is permitted in the pool.
10. Radios must be played at a volume and of content not to be offensive.
11. No running.
12. No glass containers.
13. No diving.
14. No hanging on the lane lines or depth dividers.
15. No spitting and/or throwing of water.
16. No pushing or dunking.
17. No gum in the pool area and no food in the pool.
18. No bicycles, skateboards, skates or other wheeled items, other than medically necessary devices.
19. No hard balls, such as tennis balls and footballs, or other sports-related balls.
